

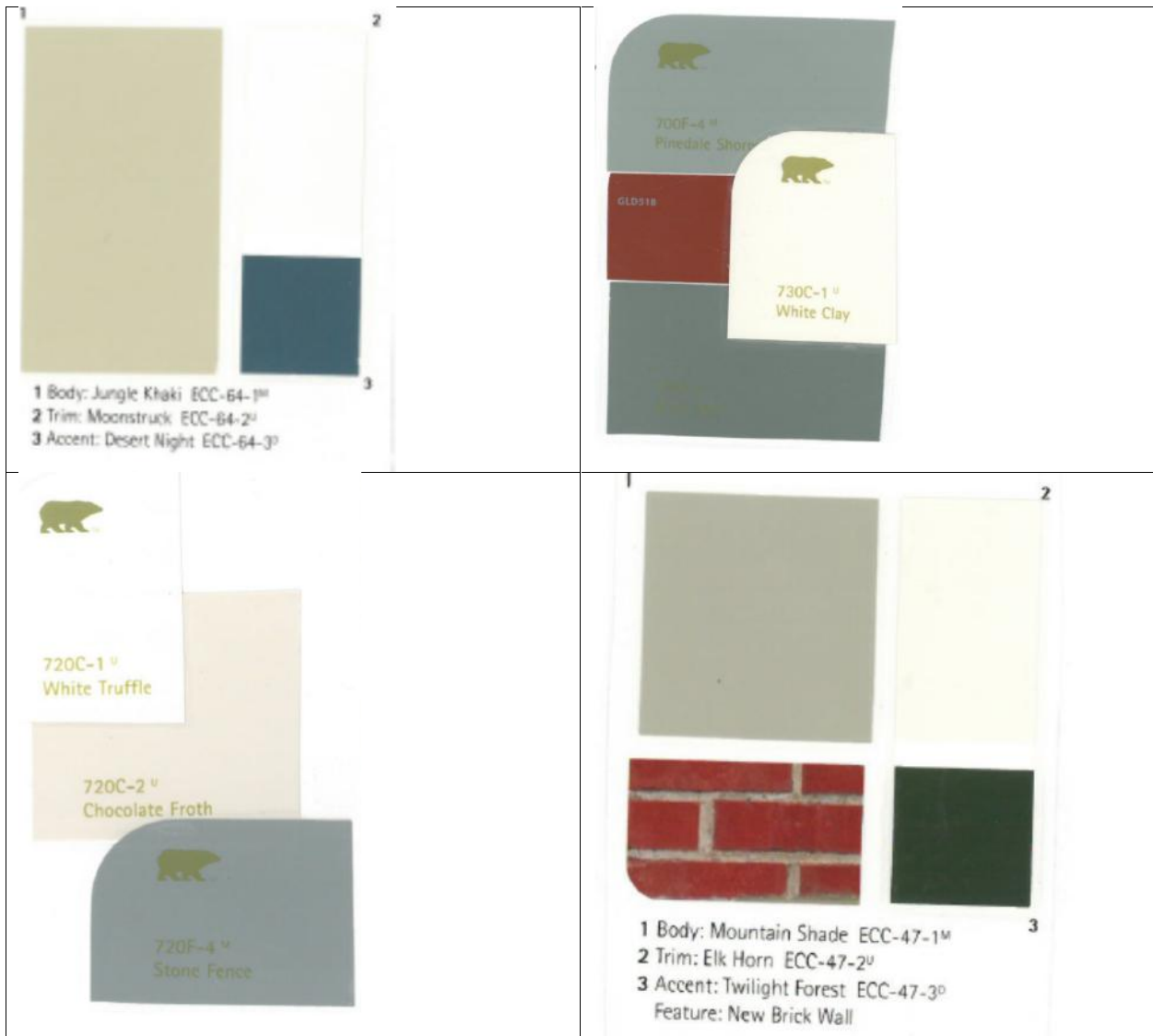

Appendix A: Downtown Exterior Building Color Palettes

(DRAFT 11/7/16)

Per Section 2.2.155, the City of Stanfield requires the exterior of buildings in the Downtown District to be painted earth tones, creams, and pastels of earth tones conforming to the approved color palettes. The following color palettes have been adopted by the City. Proposed paint colors are required to match colors on the approved palettes, but do not need to be the same brand.

Palette 1: Preferred Downtown Color Combinations





Palette 2: Historic Colors Of America collection, except the following colors:

Clementine	Robin's Egg	Blue Winged Teal
Lady Banksia	Glacier Bay	Phillips Green
Goldenrod	Biloxi Blue	Brattle Spruce

Lyman Camellia	Coral Springs	Sayward Pine

Palette 3: Behr paint colors. The following Behr paint color collection from Home Depot:

- Any color in the “White” collection except RD-W1, RD-W2 and RD-W3
- Any color in the “Muted” collection
- Any color in the “Shaded” collection
- Any color in the “Neutrals” collection
