NEW TIME FOR COURT SESSIONS

The Stanfield Municipal Court is moving to a different schedule, beginning December 1st. Previously, Municipal Court sessions were held beginning at 6:30 pm every Wednesday, which required the City Clerk to stay late for court sessions, which reduced her time during normal business hours. Now Court sessions will take place at 2:00 pm on Wednesdays. This change will provide better service to Stanfield residents by making the Clerk available more during regular business hours.

The Stanfield Police Department has started a FaceBook page to better promote communication between our community and the Department. This page will provide crime prevention tips and other information, answer questions from the community, and provide pictures of events and activities in our community.

ODOR COMPLAINTS

The City has received a number of complaints about the odor coming from the starch plant on the west side of town. The last edition of the newsletter contained a lot of information on efforts being made to correct the problem. By the end of November, the plant’s new air scrubber will be in place, which should correct the problem.

The City recently passed an ordinance specifically dealing with “odoriferous nuisances.” The ordinance bans offensive odors and imposes a fine on violators. Remember, however, that an odor that is offensive to one person, may not be offensive to others. The new ordinance requires complaints from four people from separate households within a 12-hour period. If you are bothered by an odors, please submit a complaint that informs us of when and where objectionable odors are detected, and what the source of the odors is. We appreciate your patience and cooperation.
