

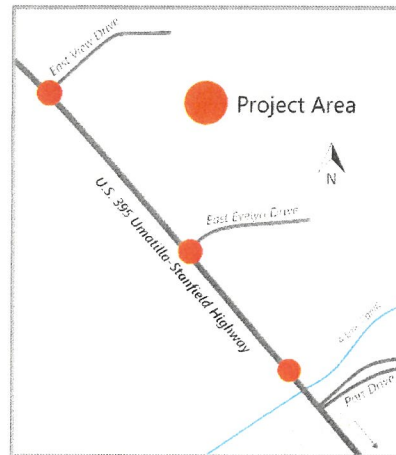
Project Information

U.S. 395: Southeast Fourth to I-84

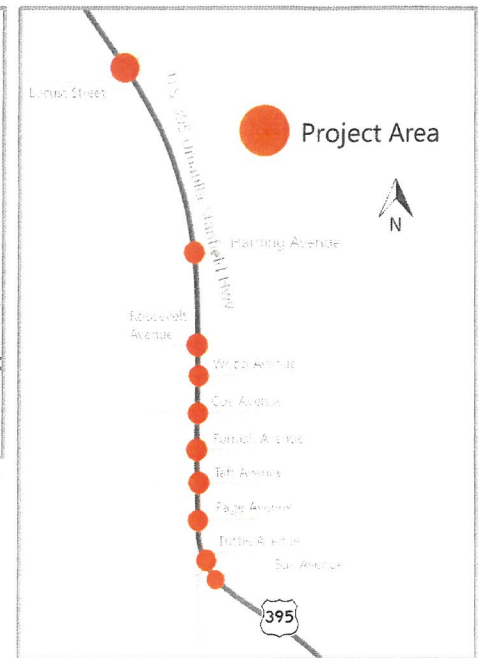
The Oregon Department of Transportation is repairing the road and improving safety features on U.S. 395 between Hermiston and Stanfield.

Project elements include:

- Upgrading ADA curb ramps, 14 in Hermiston and 62 in Stanfield.
- Paving U.S. 395 from milepost 6.03 to 12.52.
- Reconfiguring traffic lanes through Stanfield.

TIMELINE: Work begins the week of May 24 in Stanfield with curb ramp upgrades. All project elements are scheduled to be completed in October. Updated schedules will be posted on the project webpage.

TRAVEL IMPACTS: Impacts will vary depending on work and location. During curb ramp upgrades, expect single lane closures along curbs, pedestrian detours, and reduced speeds. During paving, expect one-way traffic each direction through work zones, width restrictions, and possible night paving in Hermiston during summer.
